We will begin free Grab-And-Go meal services on Monday, March 30. This free service will take place Monday-Friday (please note that we will be providing meals on Fridays despite being on a four-day Monday-Thursday normal academic schedule).

A combination breakfast and lunch sack meal will be delivered by a school bus to regular-route bus stops, and will also be available for pick-up at the school cafeteria Monday-Friday from 9-9:30am. Our meal service is limited to one Grab-And-Go meal per student per day, whether delivered by bus or picked-up in person at the cafeteria, and the child must be present. We are basing the number of meals made daily on the responses to our survey sent out last week.
