

School holidays will include *Labor Day*, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Years' Day, Memorial Day, and Independence Day. *The observance of Presidents' Day and Martin Luther King Day will be determined on an annual basis by the school calendar needs and agreed upon by the board upon the calendar adoption.* No school sessions will be held on these days. Other specified state holidays, if falling on a school day, will be observed with appropriate ceremonies.

Each school in session on Veteran's Day will conduct and observe an appropriate program for at least one class period remembering and honoring American veterans.

A day during the month of April in each year, designated as Arbor Day, will be observed by such exercises as will encourage the planting, preservation, and protection of trees and shrubs.
